Medication Assisted Treatment at CrescentCare's Suboxone (Buprenorphine) Clinics follows a harmreduction approach. We have several licensed providers who are able to prescribe medicines such as Suboxone and Vivitrol to treat opioid use disorder. We are unable to prescribe Methadone but can help link you to someone who can.

There is a cure for Hep C and it is fully covered by Medicaid. There are no sobriety requirements for Hep C treatment.
